tops off to the folk at the Bowral Brewing Company and their Pigs Fly Pale Ale, which comes with a suitably porcine picture on the label.

Pigs Fly was originally going to be called Pigs Ear, which may not have been quite as appetising.

The pale ale is made with chinook hops. It's described as subtle, with a lingering bitterness.

I'd say it's about as subtle as a flying pig, but if pale ale is your style of beer, you'll love it.
